



Being a parent is the most important and can be the most challenging job in the world. To make it easier, The Children's Trust partnered with parenting experts, Miami-Dade County Public Schools, and the Miami-Dade Public Library System to create FREE workshops and web resources on the key principles to raising successful, healthy and happy children. All parents or caregivers with children up to 16 years of age are invited to join the Parent Club, where you can ask questions, share your experiences, connect with other parents, and learn new skills to try at home.

Workshops provided are on a wide variety of topics that can support and provide new enhancements for your parenting skills, information about your child's growth and developmental stages, tools to raise competent children/teenagers, and other topics of interest. The format for each workshop offered is as follows:

- 1 Workshops are 60 minutes and available in English, Spanish, and Haitian-Creole.
- 2 Facilitators offer individualized connections to other parent supports.
- 3 Workshops are held on flexible days and hours including afternoon, evenings, and weekends.
- 4 Provided in both virtual and in-person locations throughout Miami-Dade County.
- 5 Free childcare is available at most in-person locations (for children ages 3-12) as well as special accommodations as needed.
- 6 Free snacks at the in-person workshops.
- 7 Raffles for both virtual and in-person workshops.
